- Choose from two 3-week sessions, beginning in early July and ending mid-August.
- Each day runs from 9 am to 4 pm and includes catered lunch and pool time. Early morning dropoff and extended day options available.
- Intro to Sailing, during the pre-week, this class familiarizes the sailors with basic sailing concepts, exposes them to different types of sailboats, and allows them to get a feel for the wind in their sails.
- Race Clinic for advanced sailors is offered during the pre-week.
- Basic swimming skills are a prerequisite for registration. Each child is given a swim test.
- Non-member families enjoy the use of our Club House and dining facilities during the program.

Sailboat Options

Charters or Private Ownership: A limited number of Opti, Feva, & 420 dinghies are offered for charter. Private boats are welcome after a safety inspection.

OPTIMIST: Sailors typically begin in an Optimist dinghy, which is the largest youth sailing class in the world. The "Opti" is safe, stable, and easy-to-rig. Sailors are assigned their own boat. More experienced Opti sailors spend time racing and improving their competitive skills and will compete in regattas



- RS FEVA: A two-person dinghy that requires teamwork and multiple sail handling. The Feva is suitable for sailors (12+) who meet minimum weight. Featuring a mainsail, jib, and spinnaker, it offers great training and racing experiences for sailors who are ready to move from the Opti.
- LASER RADIAL: One of the most popular singlehanded dinghies and is raced as an Olympic Class. Lasers are best suited for sailors (13+), over 125 pounds, and focused on racing. All Laser participants must own or independently charter their boats.
- SAFETY-AT-SEA & BIG BOAT PROGRAMS: sailors 14+ years old learn essential safety skills at an off-site STC sailing clinic in Session I, practice on the Club Sonar, and will have opportunities to sail on bigger boats and in regattas with our club members.
